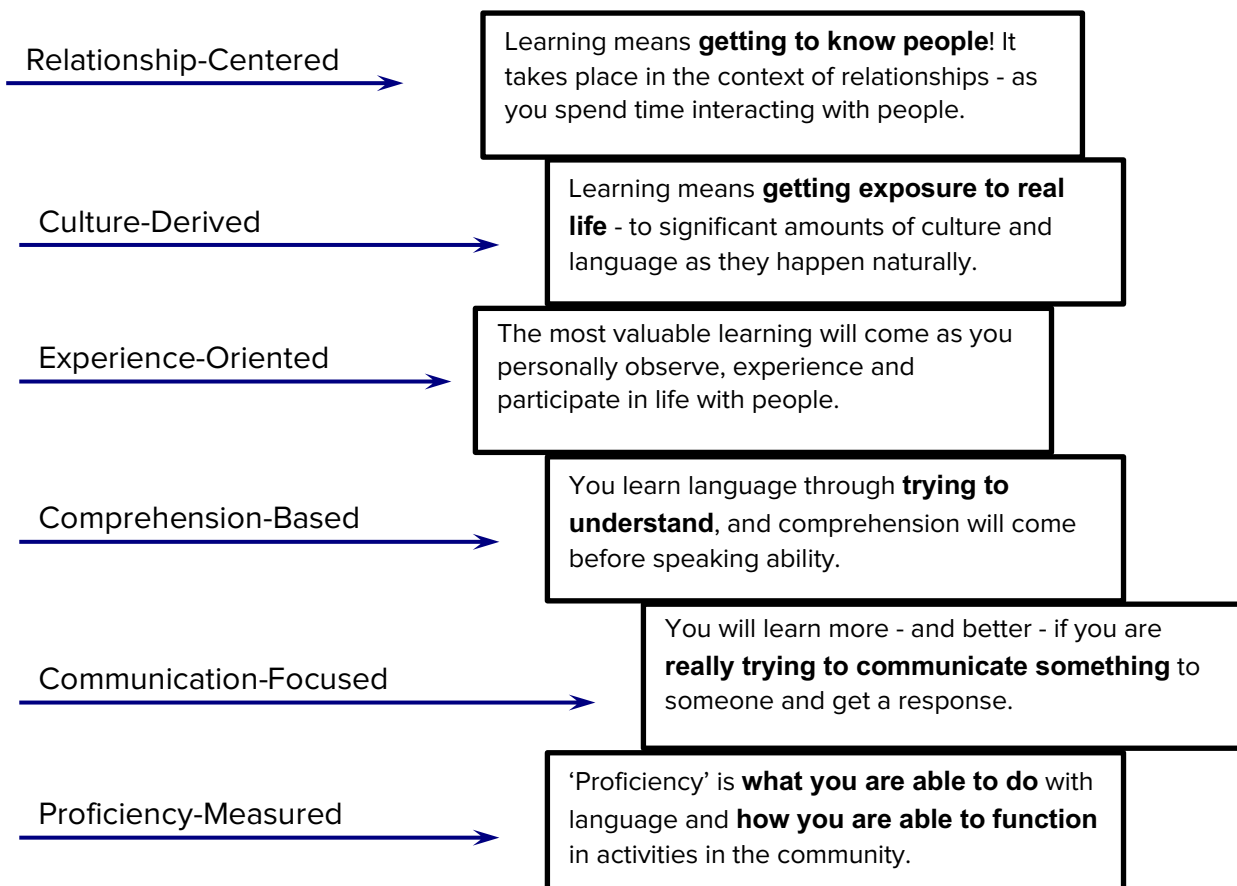
Other culture/language acquisition resources

This tutorial provides some information about other helpful resources that are available for Culture/Language Acquisition.

Introduction

There are many resources available for language and culture learning, and you will probably find some good specific helps in the particular context where you are going - relating specifically to the language and culture there. Some of your best resources may be found by speaking to others who have successfully learned the language and integrated into the culture and community.

The resources we have mentioned here are general language/culture learning materials and articles, and they are included because they are based, at least in part, on the same learning principles we value (below), and so might give you extra ideas or help.



The Growing Participator Approach

This is a language-learning program developed by Greg Thompson, a language learner and language coach based in the USA. The Growing Participator Approach is a systematic six-phase program - you can read about it on the GPA website (A quick Google search should get you there).
