## Submission Guidelines

Proposals from perspective Baptist authors and Morling Faculty are welcome, provided that the proposed text reflects our aim and scope.

Please provide a proposal instead of a complete manuscript, even if you have a complete manuscript prepared. This will enable the editorial staff to offer suggestions and feedback which might make your book more publishable, and will help us to respond as quickly as possible. Your manuscript can then be requested further into the submission process.

- All submitted material should be typed, double spaced and printed on one side only of A4 paper.
- Please leave generous margins for notes.
- Please ensure that all pages are numbered consecutively.
- Please do not send originals of your text. In general, proposals will not be returned.

## All prospective author's must use the "Author Submission Template" to submit their proposal. This is available for download on the Morling Press website and send to enquiries@morling.edu.au

If Morling Press are interested in your project you will subsequently be asked to provide:

- 3 sample chapters that represent your book's style and content.
- Details of illustrations, pictures, maps or charts that might be included, and whether you would want these to be in colour.
