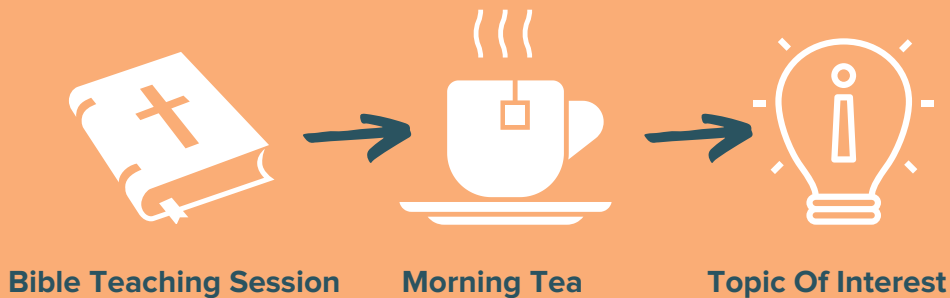
ENCORE is held on Friday mornings at our Sydney campus (or just a click away if you prefer to livestream).

Bible Teaching
**God's wisdom: then
and now**

Wisdom literature deals with the way the world “works”; teaching us how to live well. What can we learn from the wisdom literature in the Bible and other passages that speak of the wisdom of Christ and our life as followers of Christ?

Topic of Interest

How does our culture and background enrich our understanding of the Bible? We will hear from people as they reflect on a passage or story from the Bible; sharing how their perspective deepens their appreciation of God's word.

How do we see our current circumstances, our world, our culture, our profession through God's eyes? We will hear from people as they reflect on how a Christian perspective transforms their view of the world and their place in it.

Pantry staples

If you look inside your pantry you might find staples like salt, olive oil, bread, honey, yeast, and spices. Together, we will look inside the Bible to see what these pantry staples can teach us about God and faith.

Topic of Interest
