FULL-TIME OR PART-TIME?

- It takes on **average**, a total of 9 or 10 hours per week to complete one unit. This includes your 'in class' time as well as time required to complete readings, assessments etc.
- You can complete your study either full or part-time.
- 3 or 4 units studied during a single semester are considered full-time. If you are applying for Austudy you must complete either 3 or 4 units per semester.
- 1 or 2 units studied during a single semester is considered part-time.

UNITS OF STUDY:

- **Take note** of which semester the units are offered, and whether they have pre or co-requisites.
- Pre-requisites – these are units you must complete PRIOR to completing the nominated unit. For example, you must complete CHA801, prior to completing CHA802.
- Co-requisites – these are units you can complete AT THE SAME TIME as the nominated unit. For example, you can complete CHA802 at the same time as completing CHA831. You can also complete co-requisites PRIOR to completing the nominated unit, but not after. For example, you would not be able to enrol in CHA801 after CHA841, it must be done either before, or at the same time.

UNIT CODES:

- CHA indicates that the unit is a Chaplaincy unit. Some units are also taught in Counselling, and you will see them in the timetable noted with both a CHA and COU code.
- The number you see relates to the Australian Qualification Framework (AQF) number. All the units in the Graduate Certificate or the Graduate Diploma are coded AQF 8. The first year of Masters is completed at AQF 8.
- AQF 8 level units must be completed PRIOR to commencing AQF 9 level units. The exception is CHA850, if enrolled in the Master of Chaplaincy & Spiritual Care this unit is not completed.

SPECIALTIES:

- Both units from a specialty must be completed. Specialties are highlighted with different colours. You are unable to complete a unit from 2 different specialties.

MODES OF DELIVERY:

- **On Campus** – the class is conducted on campus, and must be attended on campus
- **Semi-intensive** – the class is split into several days across the semester. Times to be advised.
- **Live Online** – the class will be conducted via zoom, and must be attended during the nominated times
- **Summer School Intensive** – the class is conducted on campus for 4 or 5 days (9am-5pm) prior to the start of semester 1
- **Winter School Intensive** – the class is conducted on campus for 4 or 5 days (9am – 5pm) during the mid-year break
- **Mixed Delivery** – the class is conducted as a mixture, with either online or livestream classes and a 2 or 3 day intensive.
- **Online** – study at your own pace and time, generally one week per lesson. Also usually includes 3 livestream tutorials.
- **Offsite** – this is the placement unit. Students usually complete their placement one day per week at their chosen placement.
